

Donation Policy

The Town of St. Anthony receives a number of requests for financial assistance from various individuals and groups annually. To ensure that Council and staff have a common understanding on what we donate and to whom we donate, the below is a breakdown on what the Town will donate and to whom.

1. Financial Donations

- a. The Town doesn't make any monetary contributions

2. In-Kind Donations

- a. **Red Shoe Walk Hydro** – The Town will provide access to the Polar Centre for a 4 hour period to allow Hydro Staff (Event Organizers) to use as registration and closing of the Red Shoe Walk for the Ronald McDonald House Charity.
- b. **Terry Fox Run** – This event is organized and run by the Town of St. Anthony.
- c. **Relay for Life Local** – The Town will donate the use of the Town's property (Ball Park and Polar Centre) free of charge to host the Cancer Relay for Life. Summer only (maximum 24 hours), set up and clean up will be the responsibility of Cancer for Relay for Life.
- d. **Grenfell Foundation** – The Town will donate the use of the Town's Property (Ball Field and Polar Centre) free of charge to host the Grenfell Heritage Night Celebrations. Summer only. (Maximum 24 hours) set up and clean up will be the responsibility of Grenfell Foundation Committee.
- e. **Winterfest Committee** – We will host a community skate and closing ceremony at Polar Centre. As well we would host the opening ceremony at Town Hall/flag rising, refreshments will be served.
- f. **Ice Berg Festival** – The Town will waive the rental fee and would host the opening ceremony at Polar Centre. (Maximum 5 hours).
- g. **Youth Groups Local** – The Town will offer one of the following: 1hr free ice rental or 1hr floor rental or 1 hr pool rental.
- h. **Traveling Youth Groups and Adults (Pins)** – Groups traveling or hosting events who request town pins. Town will provide lapel pins if available.

- i. **Other Local Community Groups** – Lion’s Club, Kinsmen, Anti Violence, Chamber of Commerce, RSDI, SABRI, Port Authority, etc. will be dealt with on an individual basis by Council.
 - j. **Town Associated Groups such as MNL, PMA and Recreation** that request prizes for event draws the Town will donate an item no greater than a value of \$20.00 such as a donation of a shirt and mug.
 - k. **Individual Causes** - Fundraisers for individuals travelling for sport, sickness or anything personal will not be entertained.
3. Any other requests will be forwarded to Council for review.
